I have only one reference to this family.

On 8th July 10 James I (1612), John Whittington of Notgrove, Gloucestershire, Esq., sold to Richard Kynnersley of Earsland, gent. various lands etc in the lordship of Eardisland.

This included the messuage or cottage then (or lately) occupied by James Reignold.¹

Circumstances, which are not relevant to the Reignold family and which therefore will not be discussed here, make it likely that this premises was situated on what, considerably later, became known as Lynch Court Estate.
