

INTRODUCTION.

Hinton was one of the four manors within the parish of Eardisland, the others being Burton, Twyford, and Eardisland itself.

Stemming predominantly from a description of the boundaries which is in the Court Rolls under the date 18<sup>th</sup> October 1760, the geographical extent of the manor was illustrated in a drawing within a recent publication.<sup>1</sup> This drawing is reproduced (with permission) hereunder:



The earliest reference I have to the Manor of Hinton dates to circa 1091 and it is this which starts the first Paper of this work.
